- Using standards to drive mathematics instruction.
- Diversifying instruction to support all students.
- Creating opportunities for collaboration.
- Exploring assessment systems and the effect on teaching and learning.
- Implementing intervention strategies to meet a range of learners.
- Developing the Mathematics Knowledge for Teaching (MKT) needed for effective instruction.
