



## WMC Seeks Candidates to Run for the WMC Board of Directors

**D**o you want to get more involved with the Wisconsin Mathematics Council? Consider using your talents and become a member of the WMC Board of Directors!

**T**he Wisconsin Mathematics Council Board of Directors is seeking nominations for the following positions:

- **President-Elect**
- **Treasurer**
- **Administrator/Supervisor Representative**
- **Grade 9-12 Representative**
- **Grade 3-5 Representative**

**I**n order to be a board member, you must be a current member of the Wisconsin Mathematics Council. The position descriptions are listed below.

**T**he **President-Elect** is an officer of the Board of Directors. The position is a four-year commitment to the Wisconsin Mathematics Council. The elected individual will serve one year as President-Elect, two years as President, and one year as Past President. The President is the spokesperson for the Wisconsin Mathematics Council and presides at all Board of Directors meetings. The duties of the President-Elect include:

- Becoming acquainted with the responsibilities and duties of the President.
- Soliciting the Board members for interest in committees and committee chair positions.
- Presenting a slate of committee chairs to the Executive Committee.
- Presiding at meetings of the Council and Board if the President is absent or unable to perform required duties.

- Performing such other duties as may be assigned by the Board.

**T**he **Treasurer** is an officer of the Board of Directors. The position is a two-year term. Duties include:

- Overseeing the collection and disbursement of funds and financial recordkeeping for the Council.
- Communicating financial reports to the Board.
- Monitoring the annual budget and investments.
- Ensuring that WMC financial policies are operative.
- Serving as a member of the Finance Committee.
- Performing such other duties as may be assigned by the Board.

**T**he three open **Representative** positions are three-year terms. The duties of Representatives include:

- Attending all Board meetings
- Advocating for the representative group (i.e., elementary mathematics, high school mathematics, etc.)
- Serving as a liaison to a committee cluster, which may include additional meetings or phone conferences

**T**he WMC Nominations Committee will develop a slate of candidates and oversee the election process in the spring. Ballots will be mailed to all members. The results will be announced at the May 6, 2010 Annual Meeting during the Annual Conference.
