* **Fifteen or more years of service in Wisconsin:** The nominee must have been involved in mathematics education in Wisconsin for a minimum of 15 years as a teacher, supervisor, and/or mathematics teacher educator.

* **Active participation in professional organizations:** The nominee must show evidence of leadership in local, state, and/or national professional organizations.

* **Continued growth as a mathematics educator:** The nominee must have a continuing interest in subject matter and pedagogical developments in mathematics education.

* **Effect upon others:** The nominee must have had an inspirational influence on students and/or colleagues in mathematics education.
